## Introduction

This Global Progress Survey, five years after the UN Study, assesses progress by Member States in implementing its recommendations. Based on responses from 113 governments, 15 UN agencies, and civil society worldwide.

## Key Findings

- \* Progress in legal reform across many countries
- \* National focal points established in over 70 countries
- \* Data collection improved but remains inadequate
- \* Implementation gaps persist especially in low-income countries

## Recommendations

- \* Strengthen legal frameworks and enforcement
- \* Invest in data collection and research
- \* Allocate adequate resources for child protection systems
- \* Strengthen international cooperation
